The <u>Food Web Ecology Group</u> at the University of Konstanz Limnological Institute is seeking a highly motivated PostDoc to analyse the response of the Lake Constance ecosystem to climate change and neozoans. This project is part of the "Seewandel-Klima" project and the PostDoc is expected to closely collaborate with researchers in this project and at the Limnological Institute. The main task of the PostDoc will be to analyse the overwintering and phenological responses of plankton to environmental change using long-term data. In addition, the position will involve zooplankton sampling and processing with the Zooscan.

- Analyse plankton samples using Zooscan
- Present results at conferences and publish results in scientific journals
